Eventually, addicted to drugs herself, Danielle was drawn into the world of guys and partying and at 14 years-old was kicked out of her dad's home and found herself homeless. Going from bad to worse, meth and heroin became her drugs of choice.

Over the next few years, Danielle was in and out of prison while at the same time giving birth to three beautiful children. While she has not seen them since they were babies, she says her heart aches for them every day.

Eventually, Danielle landed in jail, this time for five months. It was here that Chrystal, a wonderful Christian woman doing prison ministry, told Danielle about Jesus. At first Danielle thought she was crazy! For the 23 years of her young life, she never knew much about God or

Since being at Safe Harbor, Danielle obtained her driver's license for the first time and was baptized on February 27th, 2022. She has been clean since May 27th, 2021, a tremendous accomplishment for Danielle! When asked what her dream job would be, she quickly lit up and said without hesitation "a nurse!" Danielle is confident that she will see her children again and acquire custody. She broke the generational curses of addiction, poverty, and homelessness over her life and her children's lives. She also led her younger brother to the Lord! He is now on fire for God just as Danielle is – her feet are on a new path with Jesus Christ as Lord over her life.

Where is She Now?

I heard about Sylvie's story when I first came to Safe Harbor 5 1/2 years ago. I loved it the first time I heard it, and it continues to get better! However, it wasn't always a good one.

In 2013, after having been set free from an addiction to drugs and alcohol 17 years prior, Sylvie was living at the Motel



6 in Gastonia with two dogs, one cat, and two birds, meanwhile driving to Hickory twice a week to volunteer at Safe Harbor's Whole Woman program. She had maxed out her credit card at a whopping \$10,000, and she was two weeks shy of being homeless.

As she spent time around the Safe Harbor staff and other volunteers, she quickly realized – she had a problem! While her challenges weren't drugs & alcohol anymore, they were codependent relationships, an obsession with pets, and a lack of financial budgeting!

February of 2014 Sylvie entered Safe Harbor's Whole Woman program – but this time as a program participant.

Fast forward eight years, Sylvie is a true testament to living one day at a time, being obedient to God, and exercising the tools she learned at Safe Harbor. Two years after entering the Whole Woman and Greenleaf programs at Safe Harbor, and graduating, she once again volunteered, but with a whole new perspective. She began saving her money while in the programs and was able to buy her own home and pay cash for her appliances, living room, and dining room furniture. She obtained full-time employment working at Sipes Orchard Home with young women and part-time at Safe Harbor. As of August 1, 2022, she became a full-time employee at Safe Harbor's Whole Woman program as a case manager! God is so good!
